Attendee Arrival Instructions

The GLC-AAPM 2012 Fall Chapter Meeting will take place in the Ballenger Auditorium at McLaren Flint, 401 S. Ballenger Hwy, Flint, MI 48532.

Guests are asked to park in the **white** spaces behind the **Genesys Building** (see map). A shuttle will pick up guests at point A, beginning at 9:15 AM on 11/9/12. The shuttle will take guests to point B where they can enter Ballenger Auditorium.

In the afternoon, guests will walk over to the McLaren Proton Therapy Center for a tour. A shuttle will take guests from point C to A, starting at 3:45 PM.

Attendees who arrive late may call Security at (810) 342-3333, to ask for the shuttle. Likewise, attendees who must leave early can call, or exit through the main entrance of the hospital and ask the attendant at the security booth to call the shuttle. Walking from point A - B is discouraged because there is construction on the sidewalks and no crosswalk available.
